PROTECT WWI MEMORIAL

Whereas the Southern End of the Common sustained significant damage when hit by a vehicle; and

Whereas the WWI monument is now unprotected from possible damage due to another vehicle strike:

Therefore, be it Ordered; the Town Manager will establish a barrier to protect the monument from potential risk.

Explanation:

A vehicle hit and destroyed the column and rail barrier that protected the WWI monument from risk. The monument is now exposed to another accident which may irreparably damage the monument. Even a temporary concrete barrier is better than nothing until a permanent solution can be established.
